2.	Register for the TEAS Nursing Exam through ATI (<u>atitesting.com</u>). Send your scores to Baptist School of Health Professions SA TX ADN.
3.	Submit official college transcripts from all institutions attended to transcripts@bshp.edu or by mail to: Baptist School of Health Professions c/o: Student Services 8400 Datapoint Drive San Antonio, TX 78229
4.	Submit a copy of your high school diploma, high school transcript, or GED certificate. If applicable, submit DD214 and military transcripts (per Department of Education and VA Regulations).
5.	Email your Admissions Advisor (rn.admissions@bshp.edu) to verify your application has been properly submitted.

After you are accepted, be prepared to provide:

- Texas Board of Nursing Background Check Clearance (Blue Card)
- CPR Certification (Basic Life Support from the American Heart Association)
- Driver's License
- Proof of Health Insurance
- Social Security Card
- Health Screening
