

## Eligibility Requirements

### Prerequisite Courses:

- **Anatomy and Physiology I with lab**
- **Anatomy and Physiology II with lab**
- **Microbiology with lab**
- **General Psychology**
- **1-2 additional science/humanities courses**

### Additional Requirements:

- **Have an active, unencumbered RN License**
- **Be a graduate of either an Associates or Diploma RN Program**
- **Proficiency in Microsoft Office (particularly MS Word)**

- Must be taken at an accredited college or university prior to applying
- The total of semester credit hours for the prerequisites must equal 18 credit hours.

### Program Schedule (may vary):

- Program Length may vary depending on transfer credit, but the average student can expect a four semester program (three semester minimum)

Schedule	Days	Courses
Online	Monday – Sunday	Online coursework, weekly assignments

### Transfer Credit:

- Generally, BSHP can accept transfer credit from most accredited institutions.
- Courses that can be considered for transfer credit are designated as general education courses.

### General Education Courses:

- 2 English Courses (6 credit hours)
- 2 Math Courses (6 credit hours)
- 4 Science/Humanities Courses (12 credit hours)
- 4 General Electives (12 credit hours)
- 2 Upper Division Electives can also be considered for transfer credit (3000 – 4000 Level)
