- Must be taken at an accredited college or university prior to applying
- The total of semester credit hours for the prerequisites must equal 18 credit hours.

## Transfer Credit:

- Generally, BSHP can accept transfer credit from most <u>accredited</u> institutions.
- Courses that can be considered for transfer credit are designated as general education courses.

### **General Education Courses:**

- 2 English Courses (6 credit hours)
- 4 Science/Humanities Courses (12 credit hours)
- 2 Math Courses (6 credit hours)
- 4 General Electives (12 credit hours)
- 2 Upper Division Electives can also be considered for transfer credit (3000 4000 Level)
