

Eligibility Requirements

Prerequisite Courses:

- Anatomy and Physiology I with lab
- Anatomy and Physiology II with lab
- Microbiology with lab
- General Psychology
- 1-2 additional science/humanities courses

Additional Requirements:

- Have an active, unencumbered RN License
- Be a graduate of either an Associates or Diploma RN Program
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office (particularly MS Word)

- Must be taken at an accredited college or university prior to applying
- The total of semester credit hours for the prerequisites must equal 18 credit hours.

Program Schedule (may vary):

- Program Length may vary depending on transfer credit, but the average student can expect a four semester program (three semester minimum)

Transfer Credit courses that can be considered are designated below as General Education Courses:

- Generally, BSHP can accept transfer credit from most accredited institutions.
- Missing general education courses will be built into the degree plan, unless specified you will be taking it somewhere else.

General Education Courses:

- 2 English Courses (6 credit hours)
- 2 Math Courses (6 credit hours)
- 4 Science/Humanities Courses (12 credit hours)
- 4 General Electives (12 credit hours)
- 2 Upper Division Electives can also be considered for transfer credit (3000 – 4000 Level)

3. Submit a copy of your high school diploma or, high school transcript, or GED certificate. If applicable, submit DD214 and military transcripts (per Department of Education and VA Regulations).
4. Submit a copy of your Vocational Nursing License to advising@bshp.edu. It must be issued by the Texas Board of Nursing or a nursing compact state.
5. Email your Admissions Advisor (advising@bshp.edu) to verify your application has been properly submitted and to request a degree audit. Admissions must have all official transcripts to provide a degree audit.
