#### **Entrance Exam:**

- TEAS Nursing Entrance Exam
- Minimum Scores Reading: 69, Math:
   63.3, Science: 45.8, English: 60
- To register for the TEAS, please visit www.atitesting.com/teas/register/
- Scores are good for 2 years; must meet the minimum scores on one individual attempt.
- Retesting: applicants can re-take the TEAS exam with no maximum amount of attempts.
