- Must be taken in the past 7 years unless currently working in direct patient care

Transfer Credit:

Health screening will be done with our student health nurse <u>after you are accepted</u>. To complete the health screening, incoming students are required to show proof of the following vaccinations. *Note: Some immunization series can take up to 6 months to complete.
