

Eligibility Requirements

Prerequisite Courses:

- **Anatomy and Physiology I**
- **Anatomy and Physiology II**
- **College Algebra**
- **Communications or Speech Course**
- **Intro to Physics/Physics I**
- Labs are highly recommended for Anatomy & Physiology courses
- Must be taken at an accredited college or university prior to applying
- Must be taken in the past 7 years unless currently working in direct patient care

Entrance Exam:

- **TEAS for Allied Health exam**
- **Minimum overall score of 65%**
- To register for the TEAS for Allied Health exam, please visit www.atitesting.com/teas/register/
- Scores are good for 2 years; must meet the minimum scores on one individual attempt.
- Retesting: applicants can re-take the TEAS exam with no maximum amount of attempts.

Transfer Credit:

Health screening will be done with our student health nurse after you are accepted. To complete the health screening, incoming students are required to show proof of the following vaccinations. *Note: Some immunization series can take up to 6 months to complete.
