There are no prerequisite requirements for the Associate of Applied Science in Surgical Technology program. Applicants must be 18 years of age and submit an online application to be eligible for admission.

Health screening will be done with our student health nurse after you are accepted. To complete the health screening, incoming students are required to show proof of the following vaccinations. Note: Some immunization series can take up to 6 months to complete.
