Prerequisite Courses:

- **College level English course (ENGL 1301 preferred)**
- Any English, Speech, or Literature course may be accepted
- Must be taken at an accredited college or university prior to applying
- Must be passed with a grade of C or higher

Transfer Credit:

- CPR Certification (Basic Life Support from the American Heart Association)
- GroupOne Background Check Clearance
- Driver's License
- Proof of Health Insurance

Health Screening*:

Health screening will be done with our student health nurse after you are accepted. To complete the health screening, incoming students are required to show proof of the following vaccinations. Note: Some immunization series can take up to 6 months to complete.
