Eligibility Requirements:

Vocational Nursing License

- Must hold a valid, unencumbered VN License

Prerequisite Courses:

- **Anatomy and Physiology I**
- **Anatomy and Physiology II**
- **Microbiology**
- Labs are required
- Must be taken at an accredited college or university prior to applying
- Must be taken in the past 7 years unless currently working in direct patient care
- Comparable courses at the Alamo Colleges: BIOL 2401/2402, BIOL 2420

Entrance Exam:

- **TEAS Nursing Entrance Exam**
- **Minimum Scores – Reading: 69, Math: 63.3, Science: 45.8, English: 60**
- To register for the TEAS, please visit <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register/>
- Scores are good for 2 years; must meet the minimum scores on one individual attempt.
- Retesting: applicants can re-take the TEAS exam with no maximum amount of attempts

Transfer Credit:

Application Checklist:

1. Complete the online application and submit the \$15 application fee for the LVN – RN Bridge Program at the San Antonio campus via bshp.edu.
*Note: Some immunization series can take up to 6 months to complete. Please refer to our website for a [full list of required immunizations](#).
2. Register for the TEAS Nursing Exam through ATI (atitesting.com). Send your scores to Baptist Health System SA TX ADN TEAS.
3. Submit Official College Transcripts from all institutions attended to registrar@bshp.edu or by mail to:

4. Submit a copy of your High School Diploma, High School Transcript, or GED Certificate. If applicable, submit DD214 and Military Transcripts (per Department of Education and VA Regulations).
5. Submit a copy of your LVN License. It must be issued by the Texas Board of Nursing or a Nursing Compact Site.
6. Email your Admissions Advisor (rn.admissions@bshp.edu) to verify your application has been properly submitted.

After you are accepted, be prepared to provide:

- Texas Board of Nursing Background Check Clearance (Blue Card)
- CPR Certification (Basic Life Support from the American Heart Association)
- Driver's License
- Proof of Health Insurance
- Social Security Card
- Health Screening

Health Screening*:

Health screening will be done with our student health nurse after you are accepted. To complete the health screening, incoming students are required to show proof of the following vaccinations:

TB Skin Test	Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (TDAP)	Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	
Hepatitis B	Influenza (Flu)	COVID-19	Varicella
