How to Cast your Laptop or Tablet to the Study Rooms (Android/iOS/Windows/OSX)

### Step 1:

Connect your device to the "Study Rooms" network

### set up connections

Access type: Internet Connections: 🔊 Wi-Fi (Study Rooms)

### Step 2:

Install Google Chrome if you do not already have it installed, same for Mac

### Step 3:

Check if you are ready to cast by clicking the 3 dots in the upper-right corner.



If you see 'Cast...' then you are good to go, you can skip to Step 4, if not, proceed to the Chromecast App section



Chromecast App: (If Chromecast needs to be installed only)

Visit the Chrome Web Store by clicking the Apps icon then clicking on Web Store





Search for "Google Cast" extension, it will look like the below and click install. If you already have "Chromecast" installed then it is the same thing and you do not need to re-install.
