ONLINE Associate of Applied Science Surgical Technology Accelerated Alternate Delivery (AAD) San Antonio, Texas

The Surgical Technology Accelerated Alternate Delivery program is a four-semester asynchronous comprehensive distance education curriculum delivered online. It has been designed for currently working surgical technologists who received their training on the job or who attended a non-accredited surgical technology program curriculum and are currently ineligible to sit for the Certified Surgical Technologist exam. The curriculum is based on the Association of Surgical Technologists 6th Edition Core Curriculum in Education for Surgical Technologists and contains a foundation of general education credits. The program will verify that students have the skills and abilities essential to the provision of basic care to patients during surgery and provide transfer experiential credit transfer for clinical and skill experience. Upon graduation students will receive the Associate of Applied Science degree and be eligible to sit for the National Certification Examination for Surgical Technologists and be eligible to continue into Surgical First Assistant training.

The program builds upon the clinical expertise of the practicing Surgical Technologist. The program will verify that graduates have the skills and abilities essential to the provision of safe patient care during surgery.
