The Baptist Health System School of Health Professions has been educating nurses and healthcare workers since 1905. The school is located in the San Antonio, Texas Medical Center area. The Bachelor of Science in Healthcare Management program is designed as a fully online baccalaureate degree completion program that emphasizes the knowledge and skills necessary to supervise, evaluate, analyze and understand the business foundations of a rapidly changing healthcare industry. Healthcare Managers plan, direct, or coordinate medical and health services in hospitals, clinics, managed care organizations, public health agencies or similar organizations.

Applicants to the program must hold an Associate degree in business or related area such as finance or technology, nursing or allied health or an equivalent of 60 semester credits received from an accredited college or university comprised of both general education and core curriculum credits.

Baccalaureate Healthcare Management Education

The program is being implemented to meet the growing demand for competent managers in health care. The objective is to enhance promotional and career opportunities for graduates, and provide the support for departmental operations, and clinical and business decision making within the health care setting. The program is designed to meet the workforce needs of the Baptist Health System and the local, state and regional healthcare community. The curricula content is comprised of both general and professional education necessary for development of professional expertise and attributes.

Make a Difference with a Career in Healthcare Management

San Antonio's healthcare management work force is anticipated to grow by 24% by 2018. With the rapidly changing models of healthcare delivery there will be a future demand for business, allied health and nursing practitioners with increased and specific management knowledge and skills.

According to the Bureau of labor statistics Medical and Health Services Managers occupations average wages nationally are \$88,580 (www.bls.gov/oes/current/oes119111.htm#ind) The BLS also projects a 22% increase nationally in health services management jobs nationwide between 2010 and 2020.
