Application Checklist

All application requirements must be completed and submitted by the application deadline. Applications that are missing any of the following application requirements will not be considered.

1.	Complete online application for the AAS in Radiologic Technology program via the BSHP website (Online Application). <i>(Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.)</i> Do not send transcripts until you have submitted your application.
2.	Submit electronic transcripts or mail All Official college transcripts showing completion of your prerequisite courses with final grades of a C or higher, <i>science courses must be 7 years or newer:</i>

3.	Submit a copy of your High School Diploma, High School Transcript, or GED certificate. If applicable, submit DD214& Military transcripts (Per Department of Education & VA Regulations). Please see VA section below for further info.
4.	Complete a background check (Background Check Instructions & Payment Link) <i>(Please do not complete background check until two months prior to the start of the first semester of the program.)</i>
5	Email your Admissions Advisor to verify that your application has been properly submitted.

APPLICATION FAQs

BLENDED I vs. BLENDED II DELIVERY:

Blended Delivery means that some of your courses will be held online, but some will also be taken in-person at our San Antonio Campus. We have two delivery options for the RT program.

- **Blended I Delivery**- General education courses will be taken online; all others will be taken in-person at our San Antonio campus. Clinical hours will be conducted in-person at a hospital, imaging center or physician's office.
- **Blended II Delivery**- *all lecture courses* are conducted online. Laboratory hours will be on campus and held two days per week in Semesters 2 & 3. Clinical hours will be conducted in-person at a hospital, imaging center or physician's office.

PREREQUISITES:

- You must complete your prerequisite courses at another accredited institution before you are eligible to apply to BSHP.
- The prerequisite courses are not offered at BSHP.

TRANSFER CREDIT:

- Generally, BSHP can accept transfer credit from most **accredited** institutions. Please email a copy of your unofficial transcript to your advisor for more specific information.
- The courses that can be considered for transfer credit are those designated as **General Education** courses which will vary between BSHP programs.

TUITION:

- Tuition will vary depending on how many **general education** courses can be transferred in.

\$27,985 – *if all general education courses will be taken at BSHP*

\$21,610 - *if all general education courses will be transferred in*
