



## Diploma for Vocational Nursing

### Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for the Vocational Nursing (LVN/LPN) program, you must meet the following requirements.

### Application Checklist

All application requirements must be completed and submitted by the application deadline. Applications that are missing any of the following application requirements will not be considered.

1.	Complete online application for the Vocational Nursing (LVN) program via the BSHP website ( <a href="#">Online Application</a> ). (Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.) <b>Do not send transcripts until you have submitted your application.</b>
2.	Register for the TEAS VI Exam through <a href="http://atitesting.com">atitesting.com</a> Minimum Scores: <b>Reading – 64.3 Math – 56 Science –43 English – 50</b> Submit your scores to your advisor once you have taken the exam. <i>We will not automatically receive your scores unless you choose to share them with us when you register for the exam.</i>
3.	Submit electronic transcripts or mail <b>All Official</b> college transcripts showing completion of your prerequisite courses with final grades of a C or higher, <i>science courses must be 7 years or newer</i> :  Baptist School of Health Professions Student Services 8400 Datapoint Drive, San Antonio, TX 78229
4.	Submit a copy of your High School Diploma, High School Transcript, or GED certificate. If applicable, submit DD214 & Military transcripts (Per Department of Education & VA Regulations).
5.	Email your Admissions Advisor to verify that your application has been properly submitted.

## APPLICATION FAQs

### TEAS VI EXAM:

- TEAS VI Exam scores are valid for 2 years.
- Applicants must take the entire exam each time they take the exam. Scores will not be combined with previous TEAS scores. You must pass the entire exam on one individual attempt.
- *Retesting*: applicants can take the TEAS exam no more than two times in a 6-month period and must wait a minimum of 30 days between attempts.
- **A maximum of three total lifetime attempts are allowed.**

### DAY VS. EVENING/WEEKEND SCHEDULES

- *Typical Day Schedule*:
  - **Mon-Fri**: Class (3 x per week): 8 AM – 3 PM  
Clinicals (2 x per week): 6:30 AM-3:00 PM
    - Some Saturday or Sunday clinicals MAY be required.

### PREREQUISITES:

- You must complete your prerequisite courses at another accredited institution before you are eligible to apply to BSHP.
- The prerequisite courses are not offered at BSHP.

### TRANSFER CREDIT:

- Generally, BSHP can accept transfer credit from most **accredited** institutions. Please email a copy of your unofficial transcript to your advisor for more specific information.
- Those who have already completed and obtained a Certified Nurses' Aide (CNA) license may be eligible for transfer credit for the **first two** courses of the LVN curriculum (NURA 1301 & VNSG 1160)

### TUITION:

- Tuition will vary depending on whether or not the applicant turns in a valid CNA license.

<b>\$17,525</b> – if the applicant <b>does not</b> hold a valid CNA license.
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<b>\$16,200</b> - if the applicant <b>holds</b> a valid CNA license.
